ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

GUIDELINES

1. Applicants for the Alumni Scholarship must be accepted to NCCU.
2. Applicants must be a Wake County resident.
3. Applicants must be a graduating senior.
4. Applicants for the Alumni Scholarship must have at least a **2.5 GPA** and a SAT or equivalent Test Score **900 or above**.
5. Financial need is not the primary criteria in determining recipients for the award.
6. All applications for the Alumni Scholarship must be submitted to the Scholarship Committee by **April 16** and include:
 - a. A completed Alumni Scholarship Application Form
 - b. An official High School transcript
 - c. Applicants with special talents should submit appropriate documentation with reference to talent area and degree of proficiency
 - d. Recommendations from two individuals. At least one reference should be from school personnel. A reference cannot be a relative.
7. Each applicant will be interviewed by the scholarship committee: three alumni members and the president of the chapter.
